Video visits and E-visits available:

Urgent care video visits are available 24 hours a day, 7 days a week without an appointment and treat many of the same conditions treated at urgent care locations E-Visits use a symptom-specific questionnaire to get you the care you need, while urgent care video visits and scheduled video visits use video to provide care and treatment.

MyChart and Zoom are available in the App and Google Play Stores.



URGENT CARE VIDEO VISIT

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What is an Urgent Care video visit?

Baptist Health urgent care video visits are a fast, easy way to see a provider. A video visit provides convenient access to urgent care for patients of age 2 and older, whether at home, in the office or while away from home. Urgent care video visits are available 7 days a week, 24 hours a day, on your smartphone, tablet, or computer. It's easy to use, free to enroll, private and secure.

You must have or create a MyChart account to use Virtual Care. If you don't currently have a MyChart account, you can sign up in one easy step by going to BaptistHealth.com/ VideoVisit or scanning the QR code below:



Video visits are provided through Zoom which will open on your desktop. If on mobile, please download the Zoom app. You do NOT need a Zoom account for an urgent care video visit.

- 4. Select a reason for your visit.
- 5. Choose whether you will use a computer or a mobile app for the visit and test your hardware if desired. The MyChart mobile app is the preferred method of connection which will cue you to download the Zoom mobile app. If you are using your computer, you will be prompted to allow Zoom to download. You do NOT need to have a Zoom account.
- Review the estimated wait time and click "PUT ME IN LINE."



7. When a provider is ready to see you, you will receive an email and/or mobile app alert that you can join the visit. Feel free to go about your day until the clinician is ready.

VIRTUAL CARE E-VISIT

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What is an On Demand Virtual Care E-Visit?

Baptist Health Virtual Care E-Visits are an easy way to connect with a provider online, without an appointment. An E-Visit allows you to connect with a Baptist Health provider using an online, symptom-specific questionnaire while logged into MyChart. The provider will review the questionnaire and recommend a treatment plan and request prescriptions from your pharmacy, if applicable. E-Visits are only recommended for non-urgent health conditions.
